How does the Junior Achievement Financial Bowl work?



Financial organizations from across the metro and surrounding areas are being invited to participate in the JA Financial Bowl.



Teams are formed within companies to secure donations for JA. Donations will help JA get financial literacy programs in Oklahoma classrooms for students from K-12. We recommend teams of 5. Teams should have a Team Captain to act as a liaison with JA.



If a company has more than 2 teams, a Team Coordinator can be selected to act as the liaison between the company, the teams, and JA. Each Team should have a Team Captain to report to the Company Coordinator. Just let JA know who is in charge of your Company or Team.



Choose a fun name for your Team. Use a bowling theme or a safari/jungle theme. There will be a costume contest the day of the event! ***Dressing up will really take you to the wild side!***



Teams should set their goal. JA recommends that each Team raise a minimum of \$500. We will help you with email templates about Junior Achievement and how their support will help students in Oklahoma stay in school and become financially responsible adults!



We encourage teams to use the JA FirstGiving website to enter their team name and the members of their team. The site explains about JA and the event, and Team Members can create their own page for use in sending an email to friends, family, and business associates asking for their support or they can add links to their Face Book and Twitter accounts. Collection envelopes will also be available for Team members not wishing to use the online feature. Cash/check contributions should be collected by Team Captains and/or Team Coordinators and turned into the JA office the week of the bowling event or at the event.



Teams raising a minimum of \$375 are eligible to participate in the ***"take a walk on the wild side" Bowling Party*** at AMF Windsor Lanes! Each team member will receive: 2 bowling games, shoe rental, dinner combo with beverage, coupon for free bowling game, and entry into great door prize drawings!



At the bowling party, teams can compete in the costume contest, and prizes will be given to Teams raising the most for JA and a traveling trophy will be presented to the company **CFO** of the ***overall team*** raising the most for JA!
